Dear parents and carers,

Please ensure you read the information below regarding alterations to security arrangements for the school.

King David Primary School meets with our Community Security Trust (CST) and West Midlands Police (WMP) on a fortnightly basis to share updates and to discuss the needs or changes of the school's security needs. In our last meeting, on 31/10/24, it was recognised that we are in the fortunate position of continued safety in our area. We have, it has been noted by CST, been extremely fortunate to have had strategic planning reviews and adaptations made to the level of visible police and attention spent on our school (in terms of keeping our school and the local community safe). We will continue to work with the local police and West Midlands Police, through CST, to reduce the visibility of the police. However, there will still be a police presence and the need for this will continue to be monitored with responses adjusted according to needs. There will no longer be a police presence at drop off and pick up time from Monday 4th November.

CST will still work with the school to ensure we have a security guard on site as well as being another point of contact for the school for advice.

If you have any concerns, please see Mrs Owen, Mrs Hind or Mrs Smyth, one of whom will be present every morning on the playground. We will do our best to answer any questions or direct them to an appropriate advisor and return with a response as soon as possible.

We will talk to the children about this in classes in an age appropriate manner today so they can have a chance to ask questions in a safe environment.

Remembrance Day — Remembering the courage of 1944

This year marks the 80th anniversaries of momentous battles and turning points of the Second World War.
