Dear parents, carers, and extended family and friends,

Until King David Primary School agrees to a Filming and Photography Policy, we will no longer allow parents and carers to film, as part of Safeguarding, we will no longer allow parents, carers, extended family members or friends to take photographs or video footage of events.

Parents and carers can take a photo of their child at the end of an event or of their own child at the Shabbat table.

If you share your photos with others, please do not put the name of the school with the photo.

`Advising parents or carers about sharing images of children on social media

Your photo and video policy statement should make it clear that parents or carers should gain permission before sharing photos or videos of other people's children on social media.

Consider asking parents not to share any photos or videos of events and activities on social media, where other people's children can be identified. Explain how sharing images in this way could place some children and families at risk.' NSPCC
