Adults who come to school do not hold the gate or doors for other adults or children to pass through.

Our office staff must ensure they are the first point of contact with anyone coming into school.

It may seem rude not to hold a door but it is part of keeping everyone safe.

Adults are not to come into school to take their child or other children to classes. Please be patient and wait for a member of staff to take your child/children to class.

Please note that we are no longer allowing parents and carers to access the school's toilets, including during Kiddush. If you have Access or health needs, please see a member of the OfficeTeam, who will need to accompany you to our facilities.

We have plans in place to change the layout of the entrance for improved safeguarding for all.
